Applicant must be:

A student attending an accredited college or university.

Candidates must have strong academic credentials, leadership and extra-curricular activities. Several scholarships will be awarded on the basis of financial need and merit. Several additional scholarships will be awarded on the basis of merit alone, one to a scholar-athlete, one for the Holy Cross Seminary and one Johnny N. Economy Scholarship. Scholarships will range from \$500-\$2,000.
